# The Art of Ostomy Care

## Saturday, April 29, 2017

### Course Overview

The Art of Ostomy Care conference is designed for RNs and LVNs with the intent to provide fundamental principles involved in caring for adult and pediatric patients with ostomies and fistulas. Nursing experts will discuss the unique needs of these patients and will review the different types of ostomies. Presentations will cover why surgical intervention is needed and how different techniques are performed. Ostomates will share their life experiences and discuss topics such as intimacy and traveling challenges.

Tips and techniques for pouch application will be provided by ostomy experts to increase the clinician's confidence and ensure patient satisfaction. A safe learning environment will be offered to practice pouching techniques and learn how to prevent skin breakdown around the stoma. The course will also address product selection as well as how to trouble shoot pouching challenges and peristomal skin complications. After attending the conference, clinicians will have increased their knowledge about ostomy and fistula care and return to their facilities ready to share what they have learned in order to improve the quality of care for their patients.

Scripps is dedicated to improving the continuum of care for Ostomates and the education of our Southern Californian nursing staff. This second annual event is being hosted by Scripps Ostomy nurses for fellow RNs.
