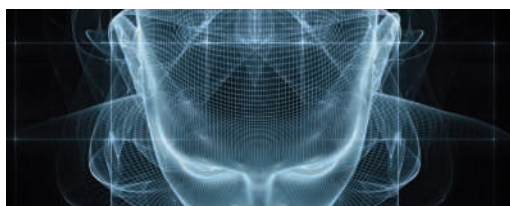


## Scripps Brain Injury and Neurological Rehabilitation Course
