- Echocardiography: The full curriculum of echocardiography is reviewed annually. Once a month - Case review. *Drs. Smith and Romero.*
- Case Conference: Challenging cases are presented to the faculty. Review and debate over the differential, review of the imaging workup, and discussion about novel or investigative therapies. *Drs. Patel and Suhar*
