



Title: **GS1 Product Identification Requirements**

I. PURPOSE

Scripps requires all Vendors to implement GS1 product identification standards (“GS1 Standards”) indicating Global Trade Item Number (“GTIN”) identifiers on all medical devices and products (“Products”) provided to Scripps. As such, Vendor shall adopt and implement the following mandatory GS1 Standards:

II. WORK RULES

1. Vendor shall assign a GTIN to each Product, to include all units of measure (i.e. each, pack, box, case, etc.).
2. Vendor shall not deliver nor ship to Scripps Product(s) unless each are labeled with a GS1 compliant bar code in accordance with the US Food and Drug Administration’s unique device identifier (“UDI”) applicable to all levels of packaging including the lowest unit of patient use.
3. Vendor shall allow Scripps access to all Vendor Product data through the GS1 Global Synchronization Network’s (“GDSN”) connection to the GS1 Global Registry to ensure compliance with GS1 Standards.
4. Vendor shall provide documentation, upon Scripps’ reasonable request, to confirm Vendor’s adherence to these GS1 Standards, including but not limited to: Product packaging, reports and other documentation and photographs.

Should Vendor fail to abide by these GS1 Standards, Scripps, in its sole discretion, may cease using Vendor’s Products and/or terminate any agreement for said Products without penalty.
