## **Standard Operating Procedure**

**Title: GS1 Product Identification Requirements**

## I. PURPOSE

Scripps Health requires all Suppliers to use GS1 product identification standards ("GS1 Standards") indicating Global Trade Item Number ("GTIN") identifiers on all medical devices and products ("Products") provided to Scripps Health. As such, Supplier shall adopt and implement the following mandatory GS1 Standards:

## II. WORK RULES

- 1. Supplier shall assign a GTIN to each Product, to include all units of measure (i.e. each, pack, box, case, etc.).
- 2. Supplier shall not deliver nor ship to Scripps Health Product(s) unless each are labeled with a GS1 compliant bar code in accordance with the US Food and Drug Administration's unique device identifier ("UDI") applicable to all levels of packaging including the lowest unit of patient use.
- 3. Supplier shall allow Scripps Health access to all Supplier Product data through the GS1 Global Synchronization Network's ("GDSN") connection to the GS1 Global Registry to ensure compliance with GS1 Standards.
- 4. Supplier shall provide documentation, upon Scripps Health's reasonable request, to confirm Supplier's adherence to these GS1 Standards, including but not limited to: Product packaging, reports and other documentation and photographs

Should Supplier fail to abide by these GS1 Standards, Scripps Health, in its sole discretion, may cease using Supplier's Products and/or terminate any agreement for said Products without penalty.
