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WHAT ARE THE HELPING BABIES BREATHE® AND ESSENTIAL CARE FOR EVERY BABY COURSES?

HELPING BABIES BREATHE®(HBB) and ESSENTIAL CARE FOR EVERY BABY®(ECEB) are part of the Helping Babies Survive® evidence-based educational program which focuses on care of the newborn. HBB focuses on newborn resuscitation in resource poor areas in the first Golden Minute. ECEB focuses on care after birth throughout the first day of the newborn's life, until the time of discharge. The combined courses will equip health care providers with skills and tools to make changes and improve care in global areas with high infant mortality and low resources.

This HBB®/ECEB® Master Trainer course is a hands on workshop which will include the Provider, Facilitator and Master Trainer components. Each participant will demonstrate skills for assessing risk and caring for infants in the first hours of life, complete checklists, discuss action & evaluation steps and implementation strategies in low resource settings.

WHO SHOULD ATTEND?

This HBB/ECEB Master Trainer and Facilitator Workshop is designed for those with experience caring for newborns and who will train birth attendants and other health care providers in low resource settings.

Due to a shortened 2 day format for both courses, all registrants shall be certified NRP Providers prior to taking this course.



HOW DO I PREPARE FOR THIS COURSE?

Participants will be expected to review the HBB® & ECEB® Learner Workbooks and HBB® & ECEB® Facilitator Flip Charts. Also review the HBS web site <http://hbs.aap.org> in advance of the workshop.

Participants will be expected to purchase their own HBB® and ECEB® Teaching Materials and Demonstration Equipment to prepare and study for the course. Participants will use these materials to teach the Provider course in the future as a Master Trainer.
