

3 EASY WAYS TO CLAIM CREDIT for Regularly Scheduled Series (RSS) Attendance

CELLPHONE PAIRING TO TEXT FOR CREDIT

1. **Visit the Scripps CME website:** Go to www.scrippscme.org and sign in using your Scripps credentials. If you are not a Scripps employee or do not have Scripps credentials, you can sign in using your external email address. Be sure to select "Forgot Password" to reset your account but do not create a new one.
2. **Access your CME account:** Once signed in, locate and click the "My CME Account" button on the homepage. Then, click on the "Profile" section.
3. **Update your profile:** Ensure your profile information is accurate and up to date. **You must add your cellphone number to your profile.** Without this step, you won't be able to use the text for credit feature.
4. **Pair your mobile phone with CloudCME® to enable the text for credit feature:**
 - a. **Text the email address you entered** in your Profile to (888) 471-8605. This step opts you into the text message attendance program.
 - b. After sending the text, you will receive a confirmation message indicating that your phone number has been successfully updated. This pairing process only needs to be done once.
 - c. **Be sure to save the text for credit number (888) 471-8605, to your contacts for easy access.**

OPTION 1: TEXTING FOR CREDIT

1. **Text the credit claim code** for the activity you attended to **(888) 471-8605** within 5 days of attending to instantly receive credit.
2. **Claim codes:** The text for credit claim code will be included in the RSS announcement email and posted under the specific activity on the new Scripps CME website under the [Grand Rounds and RSS tab](#).

OPTION 2: CLAIMING CREDIT ONLINE

OPTION 3: CLOUDCME MOBILE APP

1. **Visit your app store:** Search CloudCME and download to your device.
2. **Open the app:** Use the organizational code ScrippsHealthCME (must be one word).
3. **Login or create an account:** Login using your Scripps Single Sign-On or the email address and password you used when registering for an activity. You only need to login once.
4. **Claim credit:** Click the “Claim Credit” tab. Enter the Credit Claim Code for the activity you attended in the pink box and click the “Submit Activity ID” button. *Credit must be claimed within 5 days of attending the activity.*
