Inpatient Wards = During PGY1 year, you spend 4 weeks at Scripps Mercy San Diego with IM residents and 7 weeks at Scripps Mercy Chula Vista with our FM team

POCUS = Point of care ultrasound experiences in MSK, OB, and cardiovascular ultrasound

Outpatient Adol = Outpatient adolescent experiences including time at our high school based clinics

Elective = During PGY3 year, you spend 2 weeks of your elective with your class during a combined Community and board prep elective experience

Med subspecialty = Outpatient experiences with specialists (Addiction Medicine, Cardiology, Endocrine, HIV, etc.)

Surg subspecialty = Outpatient experiences with surgical subspecialists (ENT, Ophthalmology, etc.) combined with 2 weeks on OB as OB senior
