Frequently Asked Questions for Community Volunteers

Do I need to submit a separate application for each date and time I am available?

No, you can select multiple days and shifts on one application. Days and times with open volunteer shifts will be available for you to select.

How early should I report to my shift?

This will be outlined in your confirmation email. The start of your shift accounts for time to get oriented and educated.

Who should I report to?

You will receive an automated email response when your shift request is accepted. It outlines all details relating to your shift.

What do I need to do at the end of my shift?

Please return your vest to the same area you received it. There is no sign -process. We thank you for the help and hope you come back again.

What happens if I need to cancel my shift due to sickness or another reason?

Included in your confirmation email is a link to click on to cancel. Please use this link if you cannot make your shift so your name can be removed and someone else can sign up for your shift

Can I choose where I am assigned to work or what I'm assigned to do?

Though you can sign up for shifts in an area of your preference, staffing an event of this size is fluid, and we will assign people where the need is. We appreciate your flexibility. Non-medical/ non-licensed staff will not be administering vaccines.

Will those who are volunteering to help at the Scripps Del Mar Fairgrounds Vaccination Super Station be offered a vaccine?



Scripps goal is to vaccinate as many people as possible, as quickly as possible as defined in eligible categories out lined by state and government authorities. Our goal is not to have extra doses at the end of day, but if there is a remaining, we have a process to fairly administer extra vaccines to volunteers based on age – oldest to youngest.

What is involved in the background check process?

All non-Scripps volunteers will be required to complete a background check. For clinical roles, the background check verifies clinical license eligibility and checks the Office of Inspector General database. For non-clinical roles, the background check references the Office of Inspector General database.

How long does the background check take?

We are processing them as fast as we can, subject to the timelines of the vendor.

Will I be given the results of my background check?

We will accept your application when it is cleared. The details of your background check will not be provided.

Should I bring my own mask, or will one be provided?

Please bring your own mask. If you do not have one, we will provide one.

Am I at risk of being exposed to the virus if I volunteer? What steps are you taking to mitigate exposure during this large event?

Safety is our number one concern. Personal protective equipment is available as you need it. Interactions with patients are minimal and most of the time volunteers are more than 6 feet apart from others, supporting patient flow and observation when people are in their cars.

Will you accept volunteers under the age of 18?

Not at this time.

Will I receive any training for my duties?

Yes, education is on our website for you to review prior to coming to support our event and we do on training with everyone prior to the start of your shift.



Can you accommodate volunteers with disabilities?

Yes. Please email us at Vaccinesupersitevolunteers@scrippshealth.org if you have any restrictions we need to be aware of.

Is there a place to get lunch/ refreshments?

There is a space where volunteers can take a break and rest. There is no vendor providing lunch at this time.

Will the clinics go ahead in the event of bad weather?

Yes. We have designed our Super Site to go ahead, rain or shine. Please bring appropriate clothing as you may work outside.

How many people will be at each vaccine event?

It varies based on vaccine availability.
